

Job Posting: Elementary Math Teacher/Interventionist - Part-time

The Lincoln Community School (LCS) is seeking candidates to serve as part-time educator to teach one section of 6th grade math and provide math intervention K-6. As a small school LCS is a school where faculty and staff often take on additional responsibilities, so there may be an opportunity to increase FTE when/if opportunities arise for qualified candidates.

The Lincoln Community School is a K-6 school of 70 students nestled along the New Haven River on the western slope of the Green Mountains in Vermont. Our school's essential purpose is to insist that all students learn to use their minds well. Our collaborative faculty and staff is dedicated to coaching students in academic and social-emotional learning with a balance of rigor and playfulness both indoors and outdoors.
